

# Insurance Medical Testing

## Paramedical

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- Photo identification required
- No disrobing is necessary
- The Health Professional should be alone with your client in all cases
- The Health Professional will be asking questions similar to the questions you have already asked on his/her application form
- The Health Professional will take blood pressure, pulse, height, weight and urine sample
- The paramedical usually takes 25 to 45 minutes depending on your client's health history

## Blood Profile

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- Photo identification required
- The Health Professional will have your client sign a lab authorization
- The Health Professional will take 2 or 3 vials of blood (approximately 25cc) and a urine sample
- The procedure will take approximately 15 to 20 minutes

### *Some of the tests in a blood profile may include:*

- HIV virus
- Kidney profile
- Cholesterols and blood lipids
- Sugar
- Liver profile
- There are approximately 16 tests done on the blood

## Urine HIV

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- Photo identification required
- An authorization form is completed by the Health Professional before the urine sample is taken
- The procedure takes approximately 10 to 15 minutes

### *Some of the tests done on a urine sample may include:*

- HIV virus
- Nicotine
- Micro urinalysis
- Cocaine and the presence of other drugs
- Medications

## Electrocardiogram (ECG)

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- Photo identification required
- It can be performed at a client's home or office, however, a couch or bed must be available to complete this test
- An ECG will take approximately 20 minutes
- Some disrobing will be required
